13. **INFIELD WARM UP:** No infield warm up is allowed before your game. Designated areas are the outfields behind temporary fence and in the grove area. Warm up only in designated areas. No warm ups on the soccer fields.
14. **GENERAL TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS:**
 - A. Team manager must have complete control of his players.
 - B. Only coaches may confer with an umpire.
 - C. No alcohol or smoking is allowed within playing complex.
 - D. Absolutely no unsportsmanlike conduct is permitted.
 - E. Alcohol and glass containers must not be brought into the complex.
 - F. Any player or coach ejected from a game will follow ASA rules.
 - G. Warm up only in designated areas. No "Fence Pepper" is allowed.
 - H. Any report of damage by hotel or motel management is dealt with by the tournament committee (Per ASA code.)
 - I. NO ARTIFICIAL NOISE MAKERS OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED IN THE PARK!
 - J. Pets are not allowed within the fenced areas of the Aurora Sports complexes.
 - K. No motor homes or campers are allowed overnight.
15. **GAME RULES:** All playing rules & regulations are governed by the 2006 ASA Official Rulebook.
16. **PRACTICES: Practice times will be available. No "Friendly Games" will be scheduled by the tournament host.**
