Notes on current construction projects:

- * The King Soopers at Nine Mile Station received its builidng permit in August.
- * The Gaylord Hotel remains on schedule for a December opening and received "stocking" approval for floors 6, 7, 8 and 9. Final inspections are approx. 60% complete in the hotel and 20% complete in the convention center.
- * There were a total of 14,199 building inspections performed in August which is the highest number we have ever recorded.
