Abstract: George Friend was born in 1920 in South Dakota and before he was ten had moved to Aurora where he lived until his death in 2014. His father was a *Denver Post* distributer; in the 1930's his mother began the family business, a used furniture store at 9605 E. Colfax called Aurora Furniture, according to a 1985 interview with George Friend (Box 6, Folder 7). Friend Furniture Company was established in 1975; Friend's handwritten note gives 1925-1986 as dates for the company, and a photo of the store is dated 1947 (Box 1, Folder 2).

As an active member of the Aurora Kiwanis Club for more than fifty years, George Friend collected and saved that organization's items of historical interest, which make up most of this collection.

Arrangement: The collection begins with George Friend's memories of his life and his business - Friend Furniture - including hand-written notes, greeting cards, and miscellaneous personal items. The largest part of the collection consists of documents from the Kiwanis Club, starting with the Aurora club and ending with Kiwanis International.

Other subjects include The American Red Cross, Aurora city government, local businesses, schools, military, and religious documents. Denver area documents and miscellaneous items are at the end of Box 6. Box 7, a flat 14.5x18.5-inch box, contains large newspapers and magazines. Throughout the collection may be found George Friend's handwritten notes and lists, some of which are on the back of his daughter's schoolwork.
