Call to Order: Scott Irvin called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m.

Roll Call: City Clerk Kadee Rodriguez called roll.

Members Present: Scott Irvin, Bill McCartin, Molly Barrett, and Mike Seufert

Approval of Agenda: Molly Barrett motions to approve the agenda, Mike Seufert seconds. Motion passed.

Approval of Minutes: Bill McCartin motioned to approve the 4-19-2023 minutes, Molly Barrett seconds. Motion passed.

General Business:

Updates: Kadee gives an update that Dave Lathers has resigned, and that George Koumantakis will now be overseeing elections as the city attorney for the City Clerks office.

Bill mentioned that the City of Aurora Elections webpage no longer lists the candidates who have completed their candidate affidavits as it had in the past. Kadee informed that there is a current transition to the new campaign finance system and there are directions on the website on how to search for candidates running for office. Bill expresses that he would like those who are running for office displayed prominently on the website. Scott expresses that he would like to review the affidavits to ensure that they have not changed drastically. Kadee explained the two affidavits that candidates must submit when running for office and went over the new campaign finance system and how to navigate it.

Kadee gave an update on the Charter Ad Hoc Committee and the Ad Hoc Citizens Charter Review Task Force, and that they are still reviewing the letter submitted by the Commission on the proposed charter amendments. She also gave an update on the new charter amendment initiative petition to change the form of government in Aurora to mayor and city council instead of city council and city manager form of government.
