






Vehicular Level of Service (LOS) Descriptions

	<u>Unsignalized Intersections</u>	<u>Signalized Intersections</u>	
LOS	Description	Description	
A	Minimal or no vehicular delay.	No vehicle waits longer than one signal indication.	
B	Slight delay to vehicles.	On a rare occasion vehicles wait through more than one signal indication.	
C	Moderate vehicle delays, traffic flow remains stable.	Intermittently vehicles wait through more than one signal indication, occasionally backups may develop, traffic flow still stable.	
D	More extensive delays at intersections.	Delays at intersections may become extensive, but enough cycles with lower demand occur to permit periodic clearance, preventing excessive backups.	
E	Long queues create lengthy delays.	Long queues create lengthy delays.	
F	Severe delays and congestion.	Backups from locations downstream restrict or prevent movement of vehicles, creating a "gridlock" condition.
