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THIRD CULTURE BAKERY WILL OPEN COLORADO LOCATION THIS JANUARY

*The Original Mochi Muffin, matcha, and more from the beloved
San Francisco Bay Area bakery will launch on East Colfax in January*

WHAT: Berkeley-based [Third Culture Bakery](#) will open its first Colorado location during the last week of January 2020. The beloved bakery announced plans for an expansion to Colorado earlier in 2019, and secured a space on East Colfax in Aurora. After seven months of construction, and some unexpected delays revitalizing an old building, Third Culture Bakery will move into their new kitchen in December to begin baking for wholesale accounts. Co-founders and Culinary Director Sam Butarbutar and Brand Director Wenter Shyu, partners in both business and life, will open their cafe to the public during the last week of January.

WHEN: Third Culture Bakery will begin supplying the Original Mochi Muffin and other assorted pastries to a select group of locations in early January. Their new Colorado cafe, across the street from the Aurora Fox Arts Center and one mile from Stanley Marketplace, will open to the public at the end of January. Third Culture Bakery will host a Chinese New Year party to coincide with their opening.

WHERE: Third Culture Bakery's new facility and cafe is located at 9935 E. Colfax, part of the Aurora Cultural Arts District and a beneficiary of Aurora's innovative Restaurant Incentive Program, a public-private partnership that targets redevelopment with a focus on up-and-coming concepts and chefs.

Third Culture Bakery (TCB) was founded in 2017 by Culinary Director Sam Butarbutar and Brand Director Wenter Shyu. Sam and Wenter are "third culture kids"—children raised in a culture other than their parents—and celebrate their cross-cultural hybrid identities through their pastries. Third Culture Bakery first developed the Original Mochi Muffin, inspired by the traditions of Hawaiian mochi and flavors found in Sam's childhood in Indonesia. The menu has now expanded to include mochi donuts, waffles, custard cakes and an array of colorful beverages.
