



Welcome to Public Meeting #3 of 3

The City of Aurora is conducting a comprehensive transportation study of the Parker Road and Smoky Hill Road intersections along Quincy Avenue. The study evaluated the existing and future operating conditions of the area intersections and identified operational improvements that could be implemented in the near term (within approximately five years).

PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE

The purpose of this third and final public open house is to present the study recommendations for public comment. Community members previously provided input that was used to develop and evaluate improvement alternatives. At the last open house (held in March 2016), two improvement alternatives were shown. The project team considered the public input received and conducted additional analysis to identify the most beneficial elements of those alternatives. Those elements were combined to develop the recommended improvements that best meet the study goals. The improvements may be implemented in separate project phases.

Please review the study recommendations and let us know your thoughts about potential benefits and/or impacts of these transportation improvements. Input gathered at this meeting will be considered as the study recommendations are documented for future project development.
