TYPES OF COMMITTEES

Issue Committee

Two or more persons who are elected, appointed, or chosen, or have associated themselves, for the purpose of accepting contributions and making expenditures to support or oppose any ballot issue or ballot question of the city; or,

Any partnership, committee, association, corporation, labor organization, political party, or other organization or group of persons that has accepted total contributions in excess of \$500.00 or made total expenditures in excess of \$500.00 to support or oppose any ballot issue or ballot question of the city; or

Two or more persons who are elected, appointed, or chosen, or have originally associated themselves, for the purpose of accepting contributions or making expenditures to support or oppose the recall of an elected city official in a recall election.

Political Committee

Two or more persons who are elected, appointed, or chosen, or have originally associated themselves, for the purpose of making contributions to candidate committees, issue committees, exploratory committees, or other political committees, or for the purpose of making independent expenditures.

Exploratory Committee

A committee formed by a person to receive contributions and make expenditures on behalf of an individual for the primary purpose of determining whether or not the individual should seek election to any public office of the city.

All contributions received by a committee shall be deposited in a financial institution in a separate account whose title shall include the name of the committee.

All records pertaining to the account must be retained for filing the required reports, and at least 90 days after the closure of the account once the account balances to zero (0). The account may not be closed if any legal action is pending which involves the committee or any of its reports.
