

PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Aurora's Draft 2019 Annual Action Plan will be available for public review and comment for a 30 day period from October 11, 2018 to November 12, 2018.

The Final 2019 Action Plan will be submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) by November 15, 2018, or as otherwise advised by HUD.

The 2019 Action Plan is the fifth year of the 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan and serves as the City of Aurora's formal application to HUD for CDBG, HOME and ESG funding proposals for 2019. The City anticipates that these projects will not cause displacement of existing households. The 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan is designed to create a link between the identified needs of Aurora's low to moderate-income and special needs populations and the resources of HUD's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment Partnership (HOME) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding and other public/private investments. The Five Year Plan establishes objectives and strategies to address the needs over the next five years in three areas: provide decent housing, provide a suitable living environment, and provide expanded economic opportunities.

The 2019 Action Plan will be available for review at the City of Aurora's Community Development Division on the second floor of 9898 E. Colfax Avenue, Aurora, Colorado, 80010, and in the lobby of the Martin Luther King, Jr. (MLK) Library on the first floor of the same facility address. The facility is accessible and can accommodate persons with disabilities. The Citizen's Advisory Committee on Housing and Community Development (CHD) for the City of Aurora held its Public Hearings on the proposals for the 2019 Action Plan on July 10, 2018 and subsequent decision making meeting on July 17, 2018. The CHD presented its final funding recommendations to the Aurora City Council at a meeting open to the public on September 11, 2018. The CHD recommended the following estimated funding amounts for the 2019 Action Plan to the Aurora City Council:
