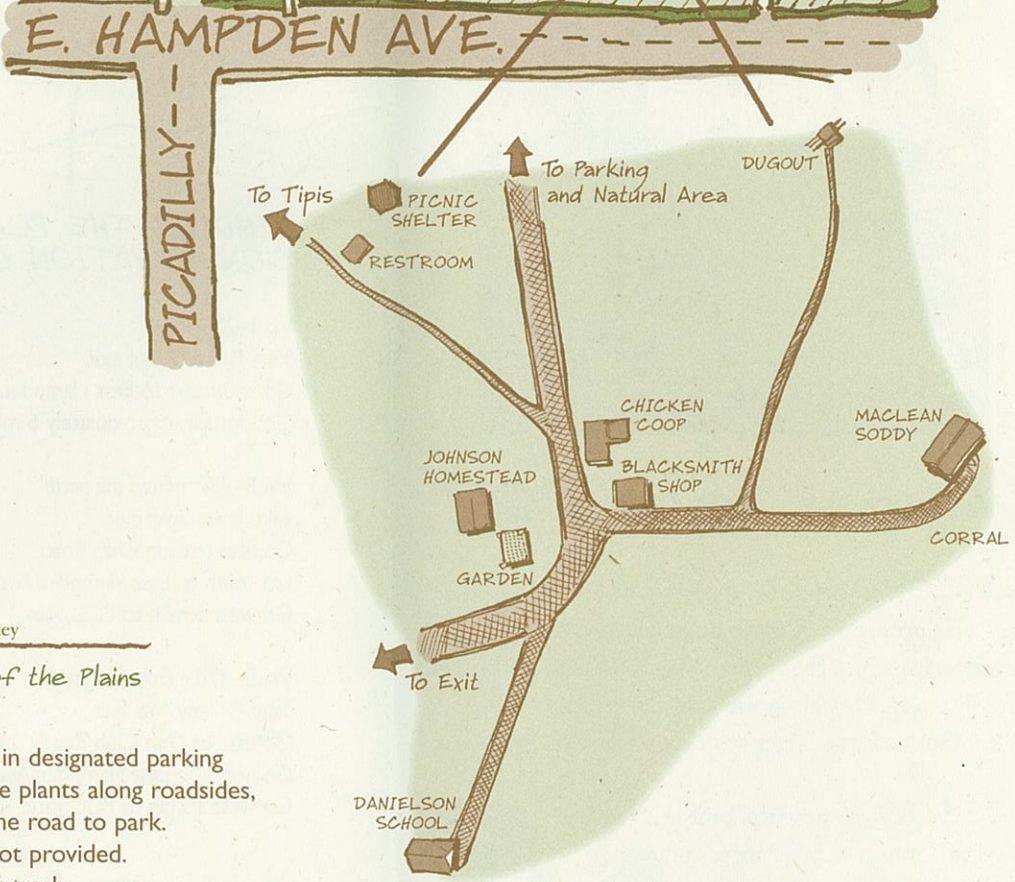
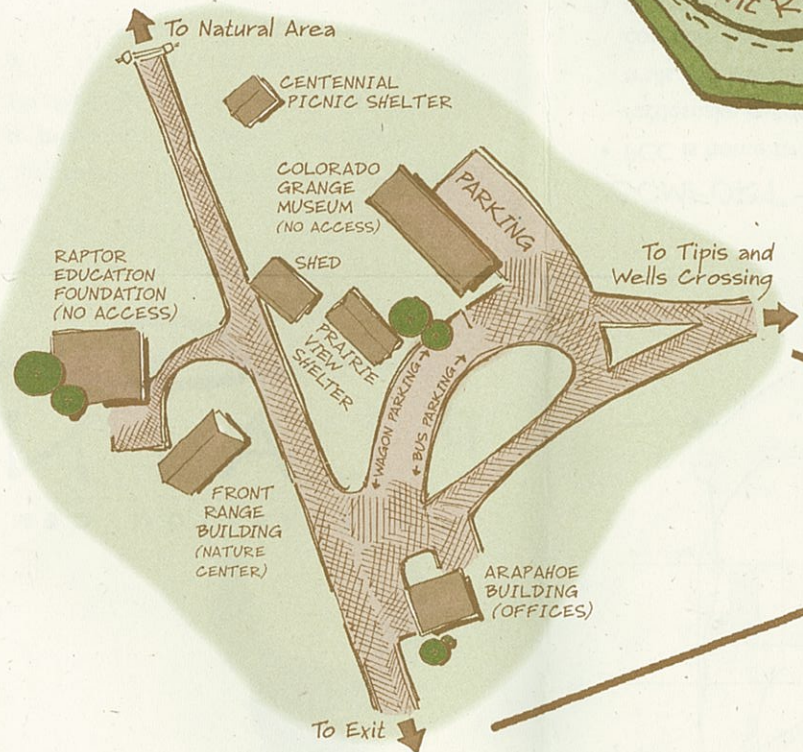
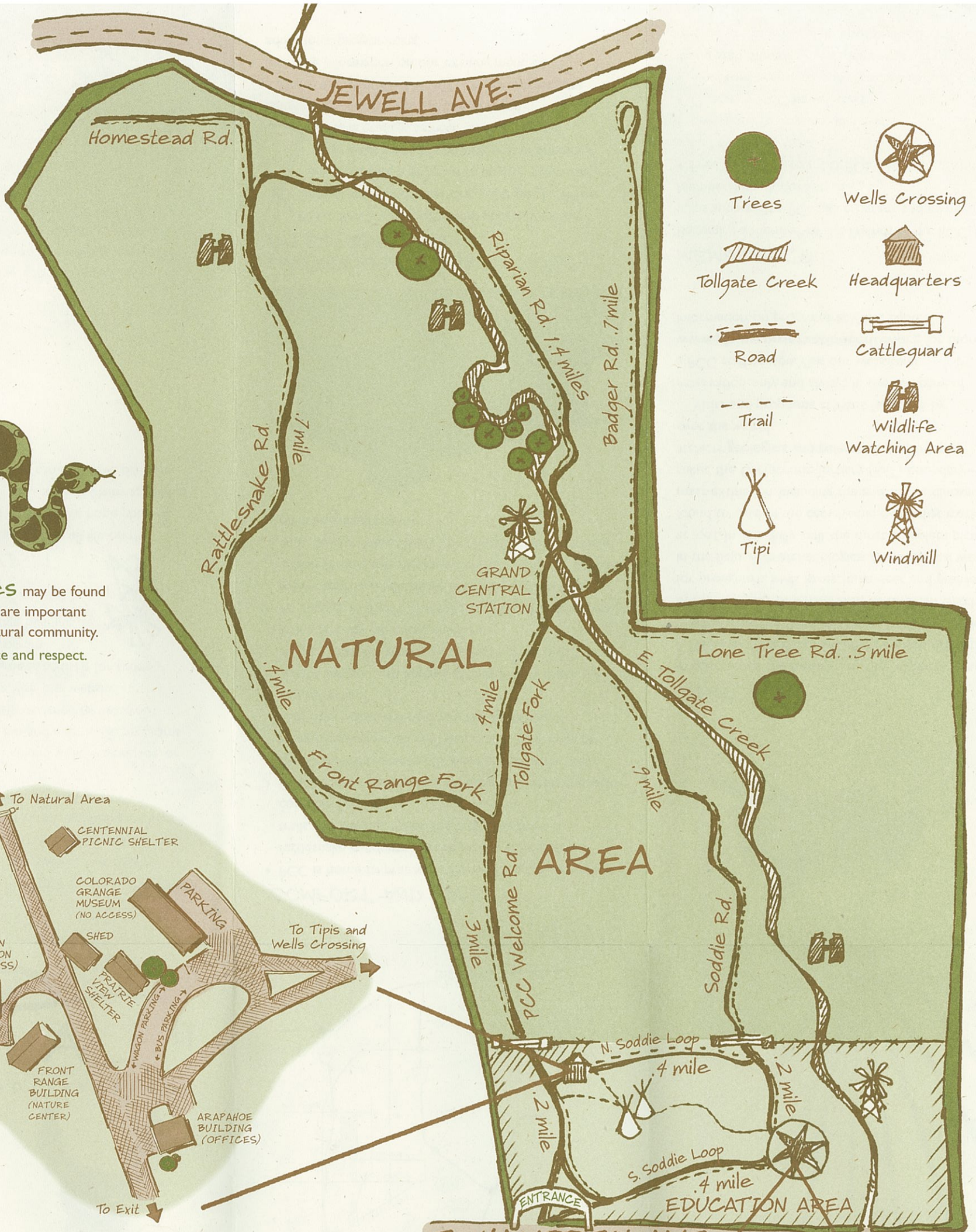




Rattlesnakes may be found at the PCC. They are important members of the natural community. Give them distance and respect.

RULES AND REGULATIONS To help maintain the natural beauty and enjoyment of the Plains Conservation Center, please respect the following:

1. For your safety and information, we ask that all visitors check in at the Front Range Building.
2. Collecting of any natural objects (rocks, flowers, fruits, grasses, feathers, and animals) and cultural artifacts is not permitted.
3. Smoking is not permitted.
4. Vehicles must be kept on authorized roads.
5. Parking is allowed only in designated parking areas. To preserve native plants along roadsides, please do not pull off the road to park.
6. Trash receptacles are not provided. Please pack out all your trash.
7. NOT permitted:
 - camping*
 - fires**
 - pets
 - firearms and other weapons

* PCC offers tipi overnights for Scouts and school groups. Please call 303-693-3621 for more information on overnight programs.
 ** Some PCC programs involve campfires supervised by PCC staff.
