



Dear Neighbor:

Aurora Water will soon begin maintenance work on a raw water pipeline located in a utility easement, between North Lakeside Place in Chatfield Estates and Dad Clark Drive in Highlands Ranch. You may already see indications that the contractor has started to mobilize.

The first phase of seven-month project will involve draining water from the pipeline. The second phase will involve repair work at approximately 24 different locations within the easement.

Typical construction hours will be between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. In rare circumstances, these hours may be extended in order to complete particular tasks. Intermittent work may also occur on Saturdays.

There will be no disruption to water services. At some locations, disturbance from the work will be minimal, but at others, work will be more extensive and might require a pedestrian trail detour. Please be aware of these activities, and look for signage alerting you to nearby construction.

We realize this project is being done in close proximity to homes and schools, so we will be working closely with our contractor and the Highlands Ranch Metro District to expedite the work, ensure safety and minimize the impacts of construction as much as possible.

Thank you for your patience and cooperation while we complete this important maintenance project. Staff are available to answer questions or provide assistance throughout the construction period.
