## LAST HIGH FIRE OF THE YEAR

Last anticipated contingent cone 10 firing for 2020 is scheduled for **Nov.25**. If the glazing shed fills before this date, the kiln might be fired before and not again until next year. Please plan projects accordingly.

## END OF YEAR DEEP CLEANING CLOSURE

We also clean out any lockers that are unpaid for the month of December.

The last week we are open is for glazing and picking up items only, no new wet work. The last day we are open for the year is **Saturday Dec. 5, 9a-4p.**
