- Modernized elevators with high-efficiency motors at Aurora Municipal Court and Central Library

ENERGY UPDATES: 2017

- Earned bronze designation from SolSmart, a program of the U.S. Department of Energy's SunShot Initiative, for the city's efforts to encourage solar energy growth
- Installed 45 occupancy sensors and 134 interior/ exterior **LED lights** in fire stations
- Installed high-efficiency, 95 percent condensing domestic hot water heater and water-saving automatic shut-off for showers and lavatories in Moorhead Recreation Center
